GUIDELINES FOR WEARING THE UNIFORM

The proper wearing of and caring for the uniform is expected since it reflects on the individual and the School community, as well as on the home. Eccentric alterations will not be tolerated: this includes extremes of hairstyle.

All items should be **clearly marked** with the pupil's name.

The soles of gym shoes must be indoor *clean* - i.e. without stones or abrasive materials which could damage the expensive gym or games hall floors. If the shoes might cause damage, pupils will be asked to remove them for the lesson, and ensure they are cleaned for the next teaching session.

Badges, other than school related ones, **should not** be worn. Boys **must not** wear earrings of any kind. Girls with pierced ears may only wear a **single pair of stud earrings**. Girls and boys may wear **one ring only** which must be removed or taped over for Games or PE. A watch, **but no other adornment**, may be worn on the wrist.

It is not sensible for any of the above items to be expensive.

PROPERTY

All personal property must be clearly marked with the pupil's name. Money or valuable items must never be left in changing rooms, desks or bags. It is inadvisable for pupils to carry money beyond daily subsistence needs. Pupils are discouraged from bringing personal property not required for daily lessons. Pupils should hand over valuable personal items/money to staff for safe keeping at games or PE lessons. The displaying and using of personal stereos in school does not present the image which Morrison's wishes to project. Other than when travelling to and from school in cars or on public transport, personal stereos must not be used nor worn while in school uniform. This includes while waiting for buses in Crieff.

School books must be protected with **brown paper** covers and clearly marked with the pupil's name. Books not returned at the end of the session, or books returned in a badly damaged condition, will be paid for in full.
